Fee Remission Scheme 2025-2026

1. PURPOSE

To assist students with financial constraint to complete schooling.

2. METHOD

To remit fee in proportion with reference to the financial situation of students' families. The school fee remission will be granted for full or half, depending on the financial situation of the applicant's family.

3. CONDITION

- i Priority will be given to the applicants receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) or beneficiaries of the Student Financial Assistance Schemes (FAS). Beneficiaries of the CSSA or full subsidies in the Student Financial Assistance Schemes will receive full school fee remission. Half rate beneficiaries of the Student Financial Assistance Schemes will receive half school fee remission.
- ii With reference to the SFAA's Adjusted Family Income (AFI), the school provides fee remission in full and half. The AFI mechanism is based on the following formula:

$$\text{AFI} = \frac{\text{Gross annual income of the family}}{\text{Number of family members} + (1)}$$

- iii Family with income exceeding the maximum of the AFI is ineligible for the scheme.
- iv The amount of remission and the number of beneficiaries depend on the number of applicants each year, which will be adjusted every year.
- v The school will grant the fee remission to students from the month in which he/ she applies, NOT from the beginning of the same academic year. Students who are on the FAS or the CSSA will not be affected.
- vi School Fee should be settled in full before the approval of application.

4. PROCEDURE
