### Chinese Percussion Ensemble Showcase Concert

Chinese subject organised a series of exploration events in traditional Chinese culture interwoven with martial arts, Chinese paper cutting, calligraphy, arts, and music. The Chinese Percussion Ensemble Showcase Concert was a cross-subject project, collaborating with the music department. A professional percussionist team from the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts was invited to the school and hosted a concert on 28th June 2024.

Through the opening with gongs and drums, percussionists played two pieces of Chinese percussion repertoire: 「老虎磨牙」 and 「龍騰虎躍」 to arouse the interest of the audience. A music jam session provided students with opportunities to explore different kinds of drums such as Paigu, Dagu, and Flowerpot drum. All students had ensemble fun through jamming with Chinese traditional percussion instruments under the coaching of professional percussionists. The other students played body percussion and body movements with teachers simultaneously. Delians loved playing the Chinese traditional percussion instruments with steady rhythm and neat body movements. The unison of Chinese drums was well synchronized and harmonised.

The Chinese – Music subject cultural exploration event enhances students' confidence, coordination, attention span and personal expression. Working with a group of percussionists, students not only build ensemble skills, but also confidence, perseverance, patience, support and cooperation with each other.

This year, we have a Chinese Percussion Ensemble for J2 - J6 students. We hope you all enjoy the wonderful musical journey in Delia!

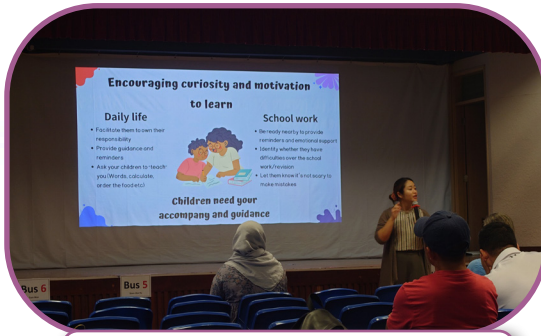

## Online Parent Talks

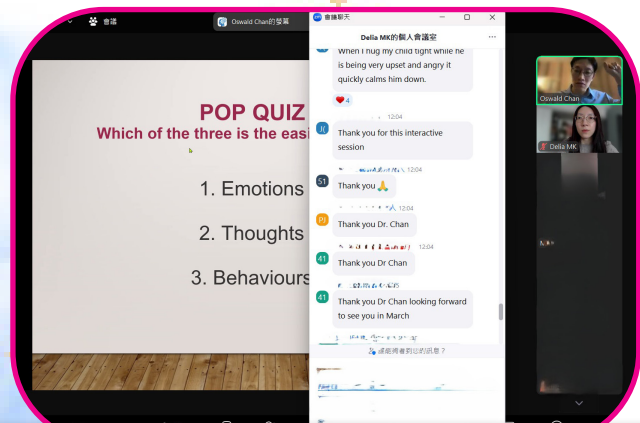
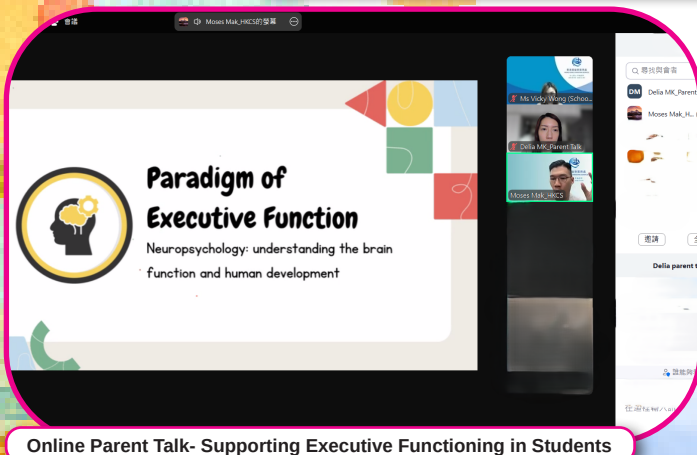
In Term 1, our school successfully hosted three insightful online parent talks, focusing on vital aspects of student development.

Teachers thoroughly enjoyed creating their own aromatherapy blends to alleviate stress.

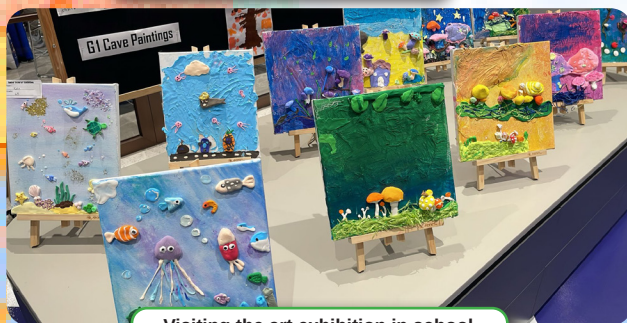


## Future-Focused School Leadership Summit

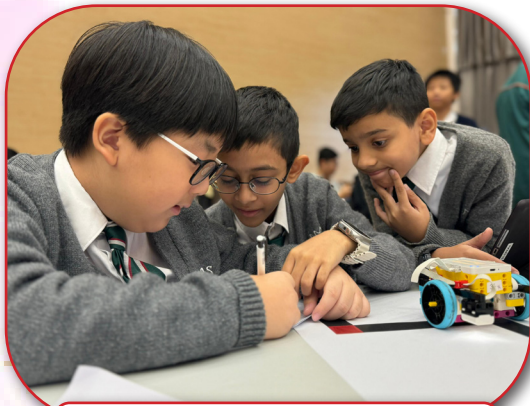


## Celebrating Our Achievers: Student Competitions

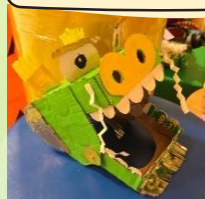
### 童趣同樂 Halloween

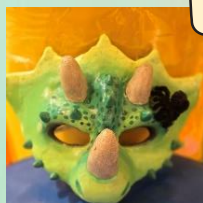

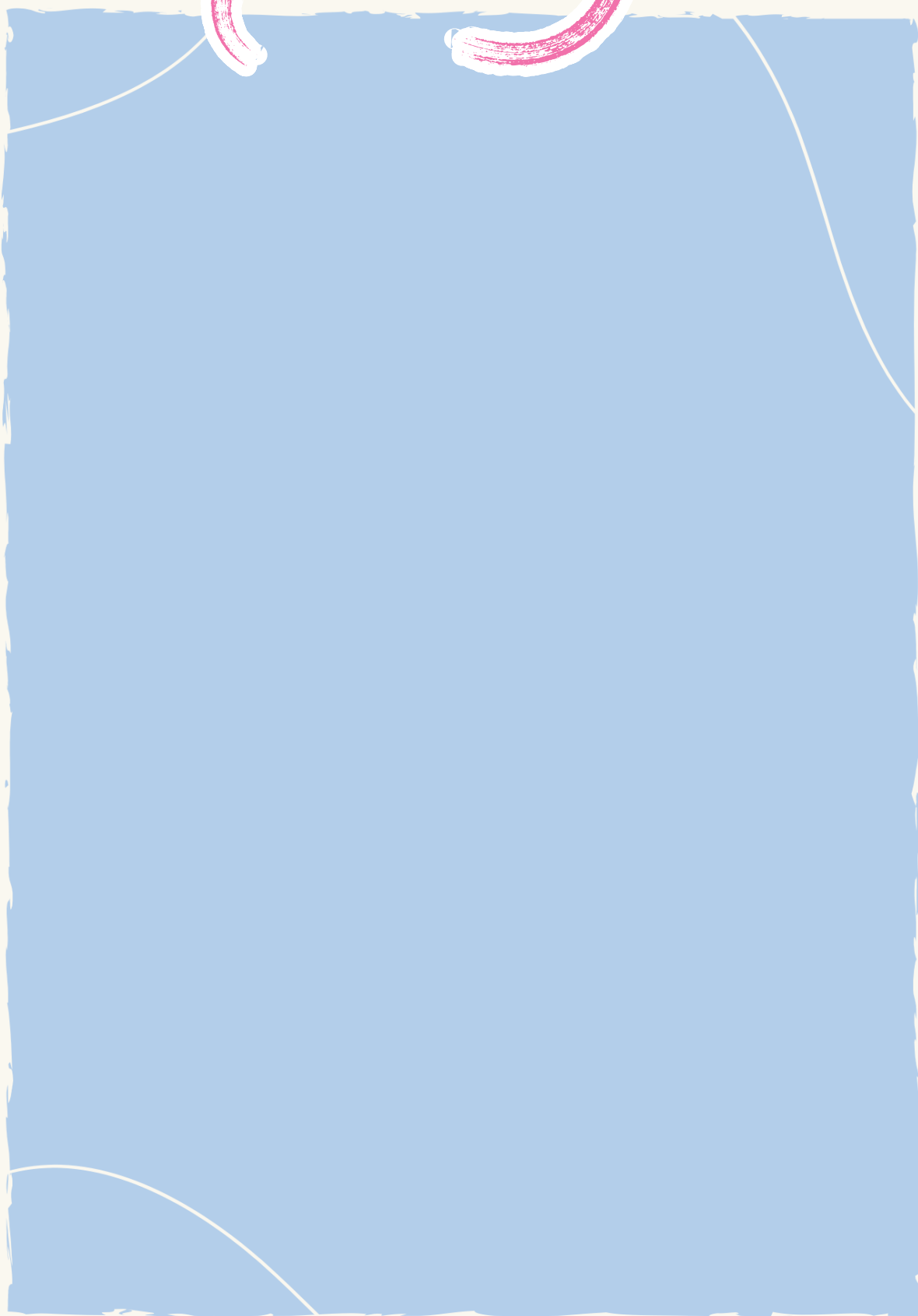

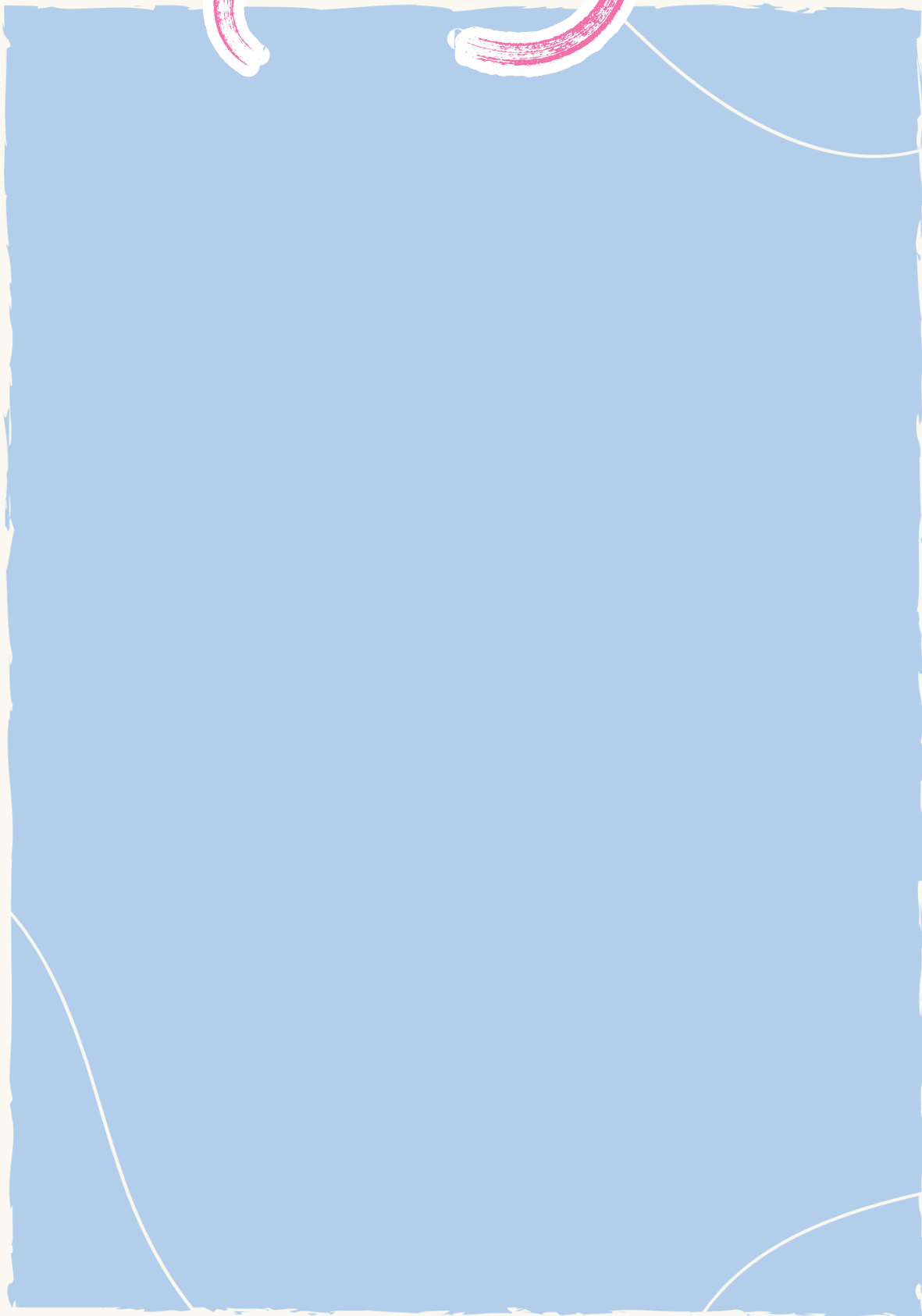
