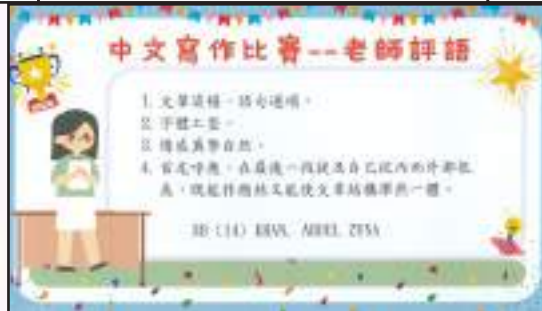
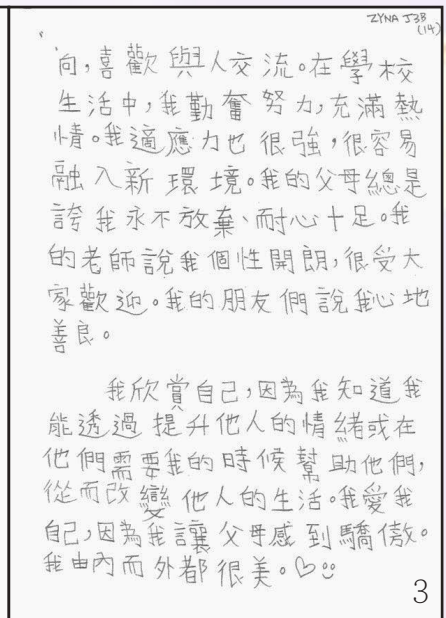
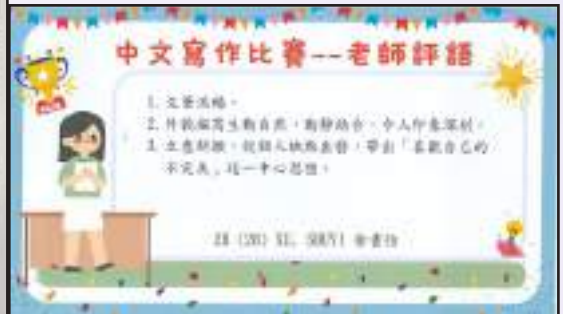
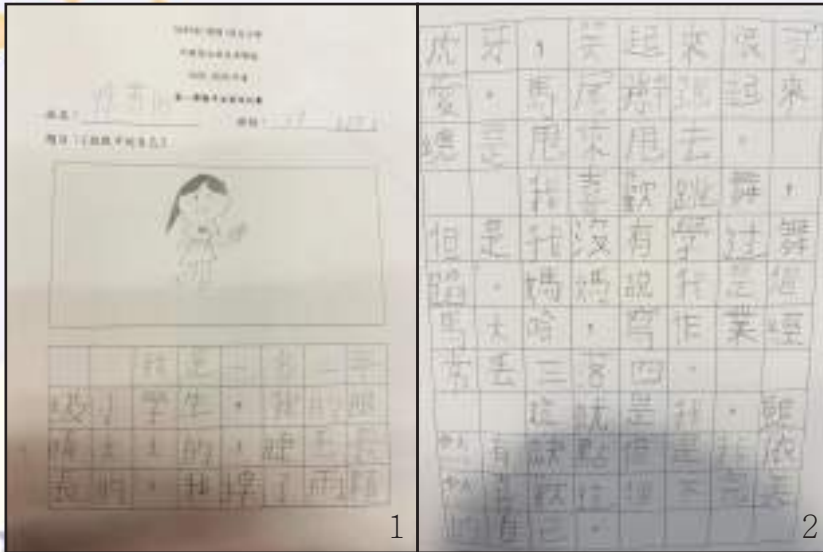
## Hong Kong Primary School AI Innovation Competition 2025



### Joint Parent-Child Cultural World Design Competition

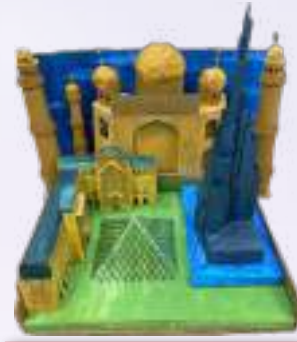
